DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

April 7th, 2024

Tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy.
On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow.

Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet.

The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. By means of this image I shall grant many graces to souls.

To fittingly observe the Feast of Mercy, we should:

- Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter (or its Vigil).
- Sincerely repent of all our sins.
- Place our complete trust in Jesus.
- Go to Confession, preferably before the Feast.
- Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast (or its Vigil).
- Venerate^[1] the Image of The Divine Mercy.
- Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.
- A Plenary Indulgence** can be obtained by fulfilling the usual conditions^[2].

*A plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in You!)" To receive the Extraordinary Graces of this Feast, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil celebration) by making a good **confession beforehand** and staying in the state of grace and trusting in His Divine Mercy.

2:00 pm – Procession of the Blessed Sacrament and Sacred Image of the Divine Mercy

2:45pm- 4:00 pm Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament; Divine Mercy Chaplet; Praises of the Divine Mercy; Consecration and Entrustment to The Divine Mercy amongst others
